Activities

Open Practice will be open for competent skiers/snowboarders. You must be at least Level 4 (ski) or Level C (Snowboard)

Lessons - We will have a few lessons and camps available. Please check the website for times and dates.

We are unable to open the toboggan, tubing, golf or Alpine Lodge until restrictions are lifted further. As soon as we can we will get them open.

Restrictions & measures

We are open to residents of Wales until the travel restrictions are extended.

All activities, including Open Practice, must be pre-booked.

We ask that face masks are worn by those aged 12+ unless exempt.

We can only accept bookings for up to 6 people from 2 households.

The changing area will be outside ski hire, no changing or congregating is allowed.

The downstairs toilets are open and checked and cleaned regularly.

There are multiple hand sanitising stations around the centre.

We clean and sanitise our equipment after each use.
